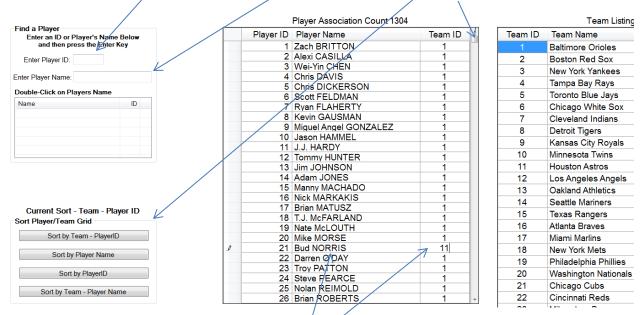
Player Movement (from one team to another team)

All players are associated to the team they last played for. If you are conducting a replay you will have to make player moves; that is, move a player from one team to another. This is accomplished in the Tab labeled **P/T Assoc**.

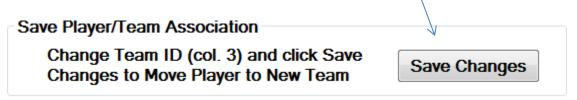

Click on the P/T Assoc. Tab

Locate the Player you need to move to his new team. This can be accomplished by entering the **Player's ID** or entering his **Name**. Or you can **sort** the grid and scroll down to the player by clicking and dragging on the **Scroll Button**.



As an example; if you wanted to move **Bud Norris** from the **Orioles** (Team ID - 1) to the **Astros** (Team ID - 11) you would locate Bud Norris in the grid and change his current Team ID from 1 to 11 and click the **Save Changes** Button (at the bottom of the Tab).



After clicking the save button Bud Norris is moved from the Orioles to the Astros.

Note: Players cannot be moved to the teams of a game in progress. That is, once a game has started (first roll of the dice) the players associated with the 2 teams playing is fixed. Any player movement will take effect in the next game played.
